Game and Time Structure

Teams will play each other once in the U7 Timbits division. The schedule is found on the WMHA web site and below.

Score clock, shift timing, and continuous play format will be followed as per regular season (there are no face-offs). There will be no scorekeeping on the score clock.

Following each game, coaches will pick a player from their own team, who they feel most deserves the Heart and Hustle award for that game. Each player will also get a Tim Hortons medal (same for each) at the end of the series from their coaches.

Safety:

- **Players and Coaches must follow all City of Whitehorse and WMHA Covid protocols**
- Players are not to go on the ice until boards are erected, and officials are on the ice
- All players must wear approved and required equipment including neck guards
- All games will be Non-Contact. Should a penalty be called, the player will return to the players' box for the remainder of the shift and a new player will come onto the ice.
